The Watermark is looking forward to your upcoming visit to our gallery spaces! In order to have the best possible experience at the Watermark, please discuss the following points with students and chaperones before your visit. Thank you!

FOR TEACHERS AND CHAPERONES

- Please be sure to count your students before you arrive and before you leave the Watermark.
- Name tags are appreciated but not required.
- Students must be in chaperoned groups, before, during and after the tour. Gallery spaces, as well as the gift shop, have no barriers so students must be supervised at all times.
- Bathroom visits must be supervised.
- Teachers and chaperones are responsible for maintaining discipline in the galleries, just as you would in the classroom.
- Some exhibits may have photo restrictions. Please check with us before arrival.

FOR STUDENTS

- If possible, leave backpacks on the bus or at the school. They may not be taken into the galleries.
- Students must stay with their chaperone before, during and after the tour.
- Please be respectful to the Watermark staff members assisting with your group.
- For your safety, and the safety of the displays, running or roughhousing is not allowed.
- Use quiet inside voices while in the galleries. Other patrons may be viewing the art as well.
- Questions and comments are welcomed! Please raise your hand if you would like to speak, and listen respectfully to others.
- To keep the art clean and safe, please do not touch the displays or set things on the pedestals.
- Cell phones must be turned off and put away during the visit, unless approved by your teacher and the gallery.
