-10 to 20 images on USB thumb drive or SD Card or similar with images in jpg format, and image size 200dpi or greater. These will not be returned. DO NOT SEND printed photographs or artwork.

- A list of images with titles, date created, sizes (height and width and depth) medium used.
- A one to two page resume with exhibit history.
- A one paragraph biography.
- An artist statement.
- A one paragraph proposal stating theme, medium, number of works, and any special installation requirements.

## Artist responsibilities:

1. The artist is responsible for shipping and shipping insurance while work is in transit to and from the exhibition.
2. Delivery. The artist delivers and reclaims all work to be exhibited, or arranges for appropriate shipping and handling ahead of time for the return of the work.
3. Exhibit ready work. All two-dimensional work must be appropriately framed, ready to install with a hanging wire on the back. Sculptural pedestals in various sizes are available for three-dimensional works.
