

Fashion Art Workshop Series Curriculum

Session 1: Designing in Canva

Objectives:

1. Introduction to Canva for design creation
2. Help students set up a Canva account.
3. Show them features and how to make simple designs.
4. Discuss inspiration ideas for designs.

Canva is free, but students will create their own account using personal email.

Students will use their own computers, tablets or mobile phones. A stylus pen is recommended for improved control to draw or manipulate designs on a touch screen.

Session 2: Adding designs to clothing.

1. Introduce students to vendors that let you customize clothing using template clothes.
2. Register for Arts Cow.
3. Teach students how to access their design and adjust it to garments of their choice.
4. Show students how to save their design so that it can be ordered.
5. How to save and re-edit later if needed.

Individual Check-Ins on Designs: Check in with each participant and help them with Any issues with designing or adding to garment templates.

Session 3: Reviewing designs before ordering.

Objective:

1. Tips to avoid printing malfunctions.
2. Checking sizes/ Ordering the correct item.
3. Sending your saved design to be ordered.

Session 4: Photographing your new garment.

Objective:

1. Share tips on how to do your fashion photoshoot using your phone.
2. Tosa will share photos and videos for inspiration.

Fashion Feature: Sharing your designs with the group.

Ordering (one garment included with registration): From the date orders are placed, it takes about 7-10 business days for shipment arrival. (**1-2 business days** for production, and 5-8 business days for delivery.)
